ITALY COVID-19 LOCKDOWN

Italy's new colors: Yellow, Orange, and Red

New Guidelines as of Nov. 6, 2020 - In efforts to curb the second wave of the recent COVID-19 upsurge, Italy has a color code classification system that classifies the Covid-19 criticality of each region. Red, Orange or Yellow indicates what kind of lockdown or shelter in place restrictions will be implemented. Color codes are assigned by the government and the Minister of Health and are determined by the degree of risk and local statistics reported in each region.

Throughout Italy wearing a protective mask is required in public places. Children over the age of six will be required to wear masks at school.



YELLOW ZONE

Curfew is from 10pm to 5am. During the day, you may leave your home, a self-signed declaration is not required. Region to region travel is allowed with legitimate reasons. All unnecessary outings are discouraged.

School remains open for nursery schools, elementary schools and middle schools. Distance/online learning is mandatory for high schools and universities.

Stores are open. Malls and shopping centers are open weekdays but remain closed on weekends/holidays. Food stores, pharmacies and tobacco shops are open.

Services such as hairdressers, barbers, beauticians are open. Private healthcare facilities are open.

Bars, Cafes & Restaurants remain open until 6pm. Take away is allowed until 10pm. Delivery times have no restrictions.

Sport clubs are open. Competitions are allowed but without fans. Pools and gyms are closed. Individual sports are allowed.

Museums, exhibitions, cinemas and theatres are closed. Bingo and betting centers are closed.

Public transportation is limited to 80% of full capacity.

ORANGE ZONE

Curfew is from 10pm to 5am. During the day you may leave your home, a self-signed declaration is not required. Region to region and town to town travel is not permitted without legitimate reasons. All unnecessary outings are discouraged.

School remains open for nursery schools, elementary schools and middle schools. Distance/online learning is mandatory for high schools and universities.

Stores are open. Malls and shopping centers are open weekdays but remain closed on weekends/holidays. Food stores, pharmacies and tobacco shops are open.

Services such as hairdressers, barbers, beauticians are open. Private healthcare facilities are open.

Bars, Cafes & Restaurants are closed. Take away is allowed until 10pm. Delivery times have no restrictions.

Sport clubs are open. Competitions are allowed but without fans. Pools and gyms are closed. Individual sports are allowed.

Museums, exhibitions, cinemas and theatres are closed. Bingo and betting centers are closed.

Public transportation is limited to 50% of full capacity.

RED ZONE

Curfew is 24 hours a day. You may not leave your home without legitiamate reasons. A self-signed declaration describing your reasons is required. All unnecessary outings are discouraged.

School remains open for nursery schools, elementary schools. Distance/online learning is mandatory for high school, middle schools and universities.

Stores, malls and shopping centers are closed. Food stores, pharmacies and tobacco shops are open.

Services such as hairdressers, barbers are open. Beauticians are closed. Private healthcare facilities are open.

Bars, Cafes & Restaurants are closed. Take away is allowed until 10pm. Delivery times have no restrictions.

Sport clubs are open. Authorized competitions are allowed but without fans. Pools and gyms are closed. Individual sports are allowed.

Museums, exhibitions, cinemas and theatres are closed. Bingo and betting centers are closed.

Public transportation is limited to 50% of full capacity.
